For Rosh Hashanah, TAI Preschool is selling local honey in specially labeled gift jars that convey New Year's greetings in English and Hebrew. The Kentucky Proud and 100% pure honey comes from Hosey Honey of Midway. This is a wonderful way to show appreciation to others who have been helpful to you while also supporting the Preschool.

Jars will be delivered to homes in the immediate Lexington area in time for Rosh Hashanah.

The honey sale operates much like the Uniongram program; each recipient will receive one jar with a card listing the names of all who are sending greetings.

The cost for each jar on which you want your name included is \$10. So, if you want to send greetings to four recipients, the cost is \$40. Additionally, you may send greetings to Temple Adath Israel staff members for \$5 per staff member. That includes Rabbi Daniel Roberts, administrator John McDonald, custodian Rachel Estep and administrative assistant Laura Creamer; preschool staff Katherine Henry, Alice Logsdon and Julie Boral; religious school director Susie Magill and members of her staff; and musician-in-residence Lorne Dechtenberg and soloists Stephanie Barrett and Aviva Bowling.
